These projects and activities support the areas of focus and can include scholarships, humanitarian projects, and vocational training.

Because the initial work of finding a strategic partner and designing the general framework of the project has already been done, Rotarians can focus their talents and energies on implementing the project.

Participation could include:

- Assessing community needs and identifying project beneficiaries
- Providing technical expertise, direct service, or advocacy
- Promoting and publicizing the project




